

Dear Sir or Madam,

at a time when publications in the media landscape are being withdrawn from the market, others are being discussed and questioned, we are planning a new issue that focuses on the topic of photography and takes a

look at the field of moving images, video and film art through to augmented reality, immersive art and digital art in order to show the cross-genre and cross-technological innovation that lies in and emanates from photography.

For more than 15 years, arttourist has been developing and publishing newspaper formats dedicated to the overall experience of culture in all its forms. The newspaper is published regularly twice a year and covers all topics. It ended for the time being with the issue ELSE 2/2019 and the pandemic and will be reissued in spring 2025. Since 2015, an annual publication appears on the occasion of world's largest jazz fair, jazzahead! in Bremen, on the topics of jazz, new music, electronic music and sound art. In addition, all topics are covered in depth and up to date at www.arttourist.com.

Since the first photo basel in 2015, back then still at the Ackermannshof, we have accompanied photo basel editorially and have been in contact and connected with Sven Eisenhut. At last year's premiere of Art Salon Zurich, the idea of creating our own annual publication on the subject of photography in print and as an extended version online has gained momentum. On the occasion of the tenth anniversary of photo basel in 2025, our first photo issue will be published. The idea was inspired by visits to the Recontres d'Arles Festival and the Images Vevey Biennale, the first Swiss Month of Photography and many other exhibition visits.

All our newspapers appear with changing names, alternating between female and male first names, and each associates an artist, to whom we juxtapose our face as the second element of the game. The first issue will be called HENRI and will feature the great Henri Cartier-Bresson as the namesake and the Stuttgart photographer and former ballet dancer of the Stuttgart Ballet Roman Novitzky as the cover face. Since the 2022/23 season, he has been Artist in Residence at the Stuttgart Ballet.

"The photographer has to capture life out of surprise, when he jumps out of bed, so to speak. Photography in no way stops life, but surprises it in its moments of highest density or rather lightness, because the point is not to capture scenes overloaded with meaning and messages. Life brushes and passes by. In order to capture it, the photographer must subordinate himself to this law and photograph as if on the move."

HENRI is published as a digital edition, like each of our last themed issues, and also in a print edition that is produced precisely in line with the display options in order to avoid unnecessary overproduction. In addition, the digital edition is promoted with a postcard and via online links. We would like to invite you to take part in the premiere edition with the enclosed invitation to tender and to present yourself to an audience and readership interested in culture and photography.


